

CLEVELAND -- A trio of Cuyahoga County administrators will help chart the course and implement the switch to a new form of county government.

The measure citizens passed required commissioners to appoint three members to a panel to help the transition from old government to new.

Those named are County Administrator Jim McCafferty, Human Resources Director Joe Nanni and Justice Affairs Director Gary Holland.

McCafferty says additional panel members will be chosen from staffers in other county offices.

A new county executive and 11-member council will be elected in November, 2010.
