REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

Cuyahoga County Department of Public Safety & Justice Services (PSJS) intends to issue a request for proposals (RFP) regarding E911 indoor localization solutions late-summer 2018. With the majority of wireless calls now being made indoors, a major challenge is the location accuracy of E911 calls placed from inside buildings. It is vital for Public Safety Answering Points (PSAPs) to be able to dispatch emergency responders to the right location for the caller. Cuyahoga County currently has 1.25 million residents and receives approximately 419,748 911 calls to its Cuyahoga Emergency Communications System per year.

In developing this RFP, PSJS is interested in hearing about possible solutions and is inviting vendors to present their product to members of PSJS. Vendor presentations will be limited to 1 ½ hours (including time for questions & answers) and will conclude Monday, July 30, 2018. To allow for the maximum number of presentations, PSJS will limit vendors to one presentation.
